



WHO WE ARE.....

Allegan County Homeless Assistance Program (HAP) is the Housing Assessment and Resource Agency managed by Allegan County Community Mental Health Services chosen by the Allegan County Continuum of Care as the central point of intake for homeless programs and services in Allegan County.

WHO DO WE SERVE.....

Persons in Allegan County who are:

CATEGORY 1

- homeless or will become homeless in less than 21 days, and

CATEGORY 2

- lacking of resources and supports to end their homelessness.

WHAT DO WE PROVIDE.....

Housing Screening to determine eligibility of which programs and services are the right match for each person and their situation.

Housing Assessment to identify areas of strength and barriers to housing access and stability.

Information and Referral to community resources, housing providers, programs, and services needed to support housing access and stability.

Case Management offered to persons who have had a difficult time ending their homelessness and keeping stable housing.
