

## **PROGRAMS AND SERVICES.....**

The first step is for us to find out what specific housing situation you are in right at this moment.

### **ESP (Emergency Shelter Program)**

**Who qualifies?** Anyone who is living outdoors, or in a place not intended for living, and unable to go to or stay with family and/or friends.

**What is provided?** Payment for a hotel stay up to 7 nights and not more than \$75 per night.

**What is required of participants?** (see [Diversion Interview Form](#))

Actively working to find and obtain housing.

### **ESG (Emergency Solutions Grant)** There is limited funding for prevention.....

**Who may qualify?** Anyone who is living outdoors, in an emergency shelter, in a place not intended for living; **OR** Anyone who must leave their home or place they are staying in 21 days or less; **AND** Gross income below 30% Area Median Income.

#### **What is provided?**

Financial assistance for security deposit and rent for up to 6 months but no more than 3 months of past due rent.

Case Management to support housing access and stability and link participants to community resources

**What is required of participants?** Actively work with case manager to find, obtain, and maintain stable housing, at least one time each month. Pay 1% of gross annual projected income for rent co-payment

### **PSH/RRH (Permanent Supportive Housing/Rapid Rehousing)**

**Who qualifies?** Anyone who is living outdoors, in an emergency shelter, in a place not intended for living; PSH also requires that a person have an extended period of homelessness and have a diagnosed mental health or substance use disorder.

#### **What is provided?**

Financial assistance for security deposit and rental assistance. PSH does not have a limit for the number of months rent can be provided. RRH can only provide a maximum of 24 months of rent.

Case Management is required for each month that rent assistance is provided.

#### **What is required of participants?**

Actively work with case manager to find, obtain, and maintain stable housing. Pay up to 30% of adjusted gross income for rent co-payment. Complete annual inspections and program re-certifications.
