The Allegan County Homeless Assistance Programs invites you to:
THE HOMELESS PREVENTION HOUSING HOUR

THINGS YOU SHOULD KNOW:

- Staff will tell you about housing options and financial assistance programs that may be able to help you end your housing crisis.
- Some of these programs have strict eligibility rules about: what it means to be homeless or at-risk of losing housing, how much rent can be paid for a rental unit, the quality and safety of the rental unit, and limits on the amount of household income.
- You will fill out paperwork and turn-in forms that will help staff assess your housing needs and for which programs you may qualify.

PAPERWORK TO BRING WITH YOU:

- Eviction paperwork, court documents or letter from person telling you to leave with the date you must leave;
- Current Lease Agreement;
- Identification Documents: SS Cards, State ID or DLs, Birth Certificates for everyone who will be living with you;
- Proof of all income received by everyone who will be living with you;
- Copy of current bank statements
